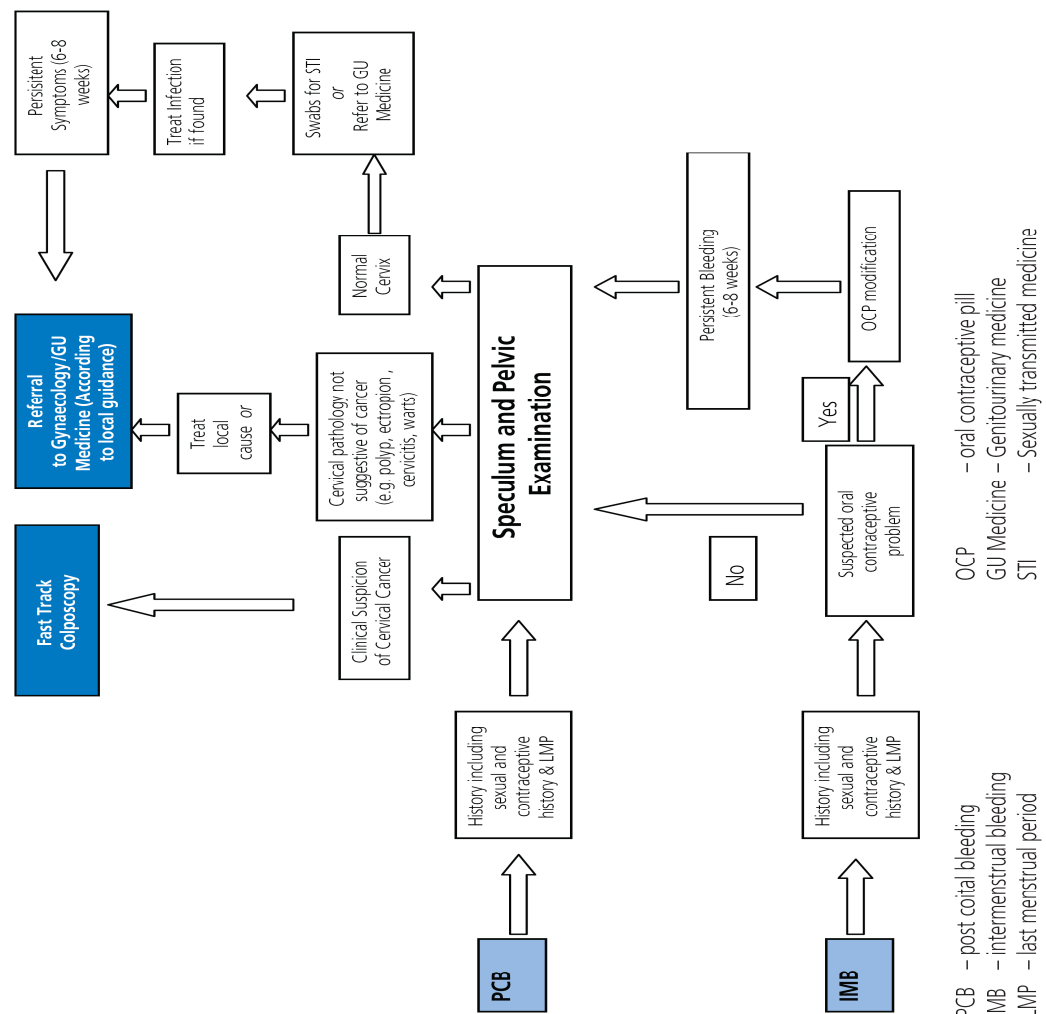

Fast track Don't take smear for these patients. Refer to colposcopy clinic if any suspicion of cervical cancer or to Gynaecology clinic if there are other cervical pathologies or no improvement of symptoms after initial management
